



Rock Climbing Instructor Scheme – Training Course Course No: 3515(E) 1 – 3 May 2020

This three day course is intended for experienced climbers who wish to introduce groups to climbing on single pitch crags and artificial structures. Its aim is to address the technical skills, judgement and areas of knowledge which will make you a competent Rock Climbing Instructor Scheme holder. You will need to practice these skills and gain further experience before returning for assessment.

Pre-requisites

Mountain Training strictly requires that all candidates are registered with them prior to commencing the course.

Once registered with Mountain Training you will have access to create your own DLOG to record your climbing and group leading experience. Your DLOG should clearly detail all your climbing experience with at least 15 led routes, outdoors placing your own protection (see syllabus), plus 15 led routes at a climbing wall and 5 outdoor led routes that are bolt protected sport climbs.

After registering with Mountain Training and completing your DLOG you need to register for the Rock Climbing Instructor Scheme through your Mountain Training account. NB: Mountain Training will not recognise completion of the course by non-registered participants. Copies of the guidance notes are available from Mountain Training.

Course content

The Mountain Training syllabus for the course is closely followed and includes an evening session, covering some of the more theoretical aspects of the syllabus. In particular we will look at the practical skills and techniques required when leading and supervising groups climbing at single pitch venues, concentrating on areas that Mountain Training feels it is difficult for candidates to learn on their own. The programme may be revised at short notice to take account of weather and other considerations. A detailed programme will be sent to you one month before the course.

All our staff are dedicated, qualified climbers with a great depth of knowledge of the local crags and will be keen to pass on their knowledge to you.

- Personal climbing clothing
- Rock boots
- Harness
- Helmet
- Belay device
- Climbing rack (or any hardware you have)
- Prussik loops
- Waterproof top and bottoms
- Hat and gloves
- Day rucksack with liner
- Small first aid kit
- Water bottle
- Flask
- Walking boots
- Notebook and pens




White Hall's location

White Hall Centre is 3 miles north of Buxton on the A5004. Landranger map sheet 1191:50,000 Grid ref: 032 763


Health and Fitness
