



<u>COURSE NO: 3247(D) & 3251 & 3253(C)</u> <u>MOUNTAIN LEADER TRAINING</u> 14 – 15 MARCH & 11 – 12 APRIL & 25 – 26 APRIL 2015

This six day course is intended for experienced hill walkers who wish to become leaders in the British mountains. Its aim is to address the technical skills, judgement and areas of knowledge which will make you a competent leader. You will need to practice these skills and gain further experience before returning for assessment.

Pre-requisites

Mountain Training strictly requires that all students are registered prior to commencing the course. The Board will not recognise completion of the course by non-registered participants. Copies of the guidance notes are available from Mountain Training. Bring your logbook to the course fully completed with your experience. You will benefit most from the course if you are fit and have experience of using a map and compass in the mountain environment.

The Mountain Training syllabus for the course is closely followed.
